Responsibilities of Anti-Ragging Committee

Anti-Ragging Committee authorized by him in this behalf, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within 24 hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions relating to one or more of the following, namely:

- Abetment to ragging
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt
- Wrongful confinement
- Use of criminal force
- Physical or psychological humiliation
- Other offences following from the definition of "Ragging"

Responsibilities of Squads In-Charge of Anti Ragging Committee

Committee In-charge will be Responsible for the following in their areas:

- They will carry out surprise checks in probable areas of ragging.
- In case of any incidence noticed on the spot, assessment of the incidence be made and necessary action to be taken and inform the control cell immediately in given Performa.
- · Ensure anti ragging instructions are displayed at prominent places in their areas ofcontrol.
