Procedure for Filing complaint:

The complaint must be made in writing and submitted to the Women Grievance Committee and be sent either by post or given in person. The Women Grievance Committee also has the powers to extend the time-limit for reporting by not more than three days, if it is satisfied that the circumstances were such which prevented the employee from filing a complaint within the three days.

If an aggrieved woman is unable to make a written complaint by herself on account of her physical incapacity, a complaint can be filed by:

- Her relative or friend.
- Her co-worker.
- An officer of the National Commission for Women or State Women's Commission.
- Any person who knows about the incident, with the written consent of the aggrievedwoman.
